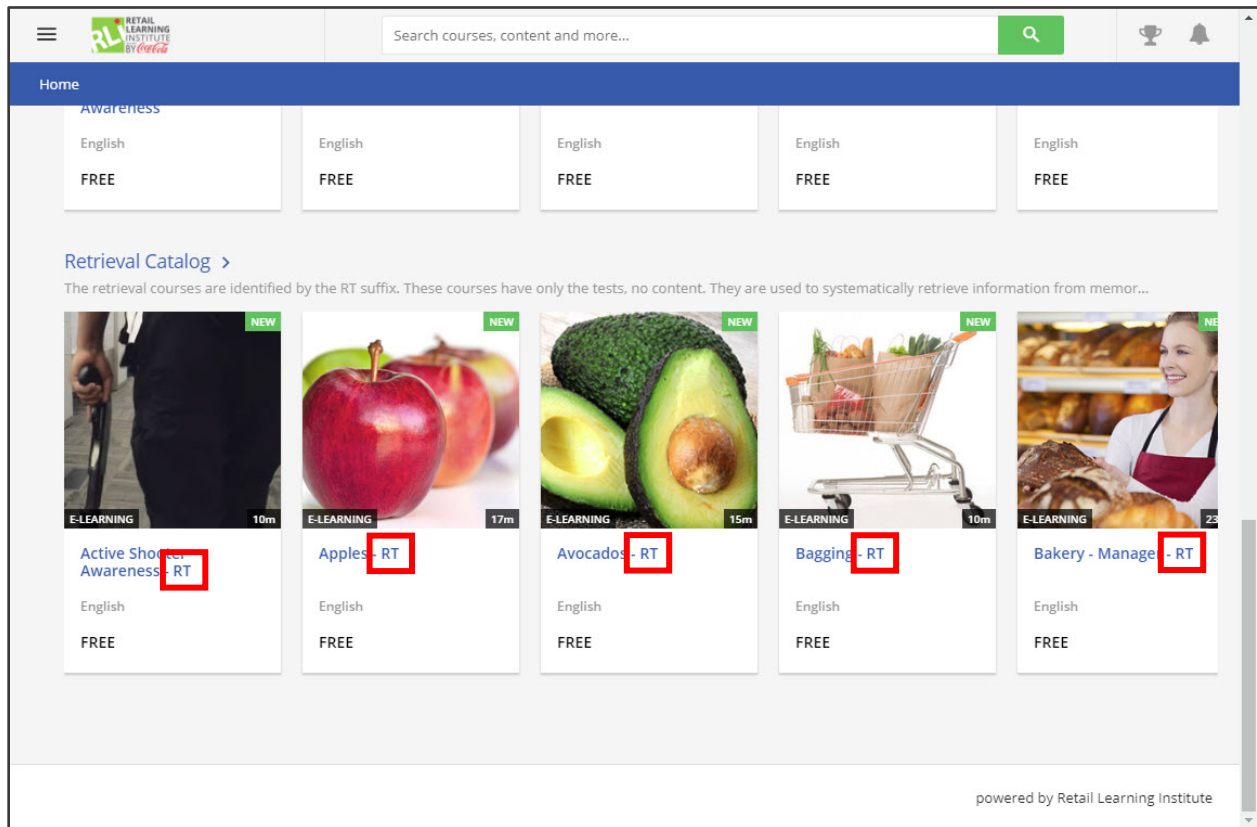


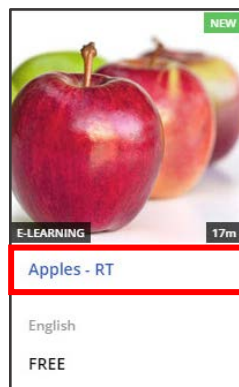
## About RT and Content Courses

Retrieval Test courses, known as **RT courses**, are easily identified by the “RT” label found at the end of the course title.

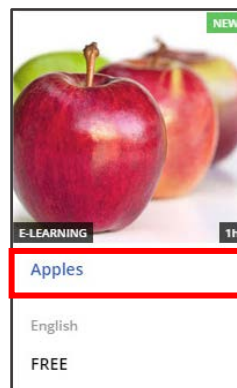


RT courses make up about half of our courses, as they are intended to supplement our other online courses, which we'll refer to as content courses.

Course landing page (RT Course)

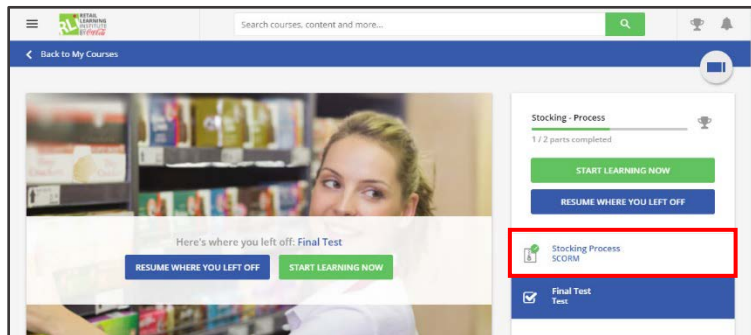

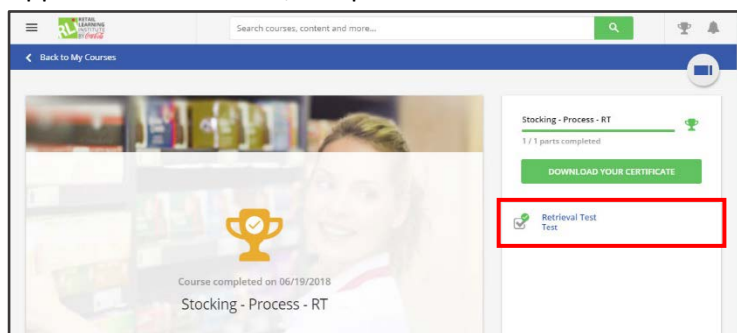
**Our recommendation — Utilize both the content course and the RT course.**

1. Complete any informational learning materials within the content course.



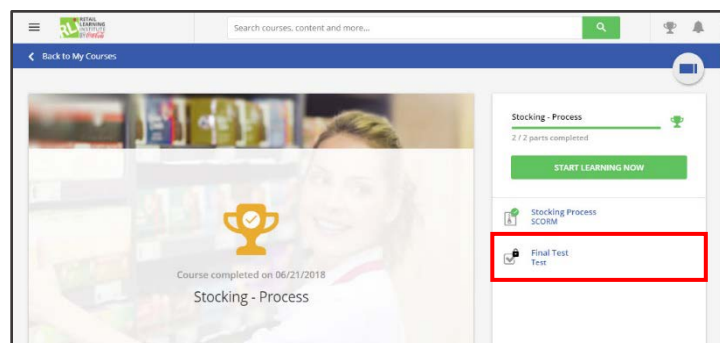
*Content Course – Informational materials completed*
